### Notes:

- Trinity registrations at Wonderlit usually open in July for exams that take place in November/December, with fees payable based on type (individual/solo, pair, or group) and examination grade levels. Target grades and types can be adjusted based on students' readiness, proficiency, and maturity.
- Preparation for Trinity exams will begin in Term 3 during lessons and will follow a 12-to-15-week preparation plan.
- Supplementary one-on-one coaching lessons can be organized and customized to meet the individual needs of the students.
- Although not compulsory, students at Wonderlit are encouraged to participate progressively in the graded examinations, receiving internationally recognized certifications that acknowledge and celebrate their achievements while honing the necessary communication skills for future success.
- Trinity graded exams are designed to support the development of a range of transferable 21st-century skills that positively impact both education and the workplace. The exams assess the following skills through various contexts: verbal and non-verbal communication, performance, conversation and discussion, critical thinking and problem-solving, research and reflection, presentation, persuasion and negotiation, planning and preparation, effective use of equipment and materials to aid communication, and interpersonal skills.
- Individuals with Trinity's Grade 6–8 qualifications are eligible for UCAS (Universities and Colleges Admissions Service) points if they are applying to colleges and universities in the UK, US, and Canada.
